1. MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING

The minutes of the meeting held on 02/07/11 were accepted as a true record, proposed by Bill Purvis, seconded by David Spence.

4. TREASURERS REPORT

Balance is £4507.23.

Should talk about AGM at next meeting.

John has come forward with three ideas to put to the membership for us to fund this year.

- 1. To erect redundant floodlight pilings from Meadowmill at Old Shielfield, so that it can be used for training.
- 2. New sprinkler system for pitch.
- 3. Training kits, match balls etc for Reserves.

Colin would put out an email to the membership for feedback, as well as articles on the website and in a programme. Each would have a bit of background on them, John would supply this information. *ACTION*

5. YOUTH SECTION REPORT

Nothing to report, however Dale pointed out that members, particularly office bearers were all getting older and would probably be going off to university or college next year. This would need to be looked at from now to enable junior section to continue.

Junior (up to 13 yrs) season tickets had gone down well. It is proposed to give away Zoo hats to the first few through the turnstiles.

7. RESERVES

8. CLUB REPORT

John explained the current financial position, and how the Club are looking to recoup the deficit (not counting the Celtic match money) Bits and pieces of money are coming in from Cup matches.

Paul Curry is training with Hamilton who have 2 weeks to make a bid. Replica shirts should be out soon, there are 22 on pre-order. The shop would be open on Monday evening to buy for the Hibs match.

Alan Bell is to take over running the website, which will be relaunched with a new address.

A 17 year old girl is doing the SFL TV filming, supported by Merrick from the Youth Project. Could do with a pool of, say, 2 more people. A request could go in programmes. *ACTION*

Club is struggling to get ex players available for the Legends Dinner/Match on April 21st.

9. SD SCOTTISH COUNCIL

There is a meeting on Sunday 21st. The demise of SD Scotland has been stopped, almost 50% of MSP's have signed up to support it. It is hoped that there is funding for the next three years.
