Ian Little and Robbie Horn have signed contracts for next season and will continue building their team. Travel grants will continue to school and youth groups at the Queens Park match there were 3 groups at the game, all with positive feedback.

Berwick are committed to the Reserves and cash has been put aside for this, Mark Lamb has done a brilliant job.

Stephen Scott stated on kids season tickets that if the price of a ticket was put to £25 and they received one of the new home tops it would raise the club profile and promote the club in a positive light, also for match mascot, if the price was put up to include a top to be worn for the match and that players could sign, it would bring together players and fans.

9. MEETING WITH BRIAN PORTEOUS

The meeting with Brian Porteous (Berwick Rangers Chairman) was an informal meeting in which five topics were discussed:

- (a) Changes to the Supporters Trust board
- (b) The matter of a certain individual sponsoring games was raised because of Trust members concerns. Brian Porteous explained that the club's view is that as long he behaves himself at Shielfield, the club will accept him as a sponsor. Now that this has been flagged up, should this become a problem the club have been made aware.
- (c) Mr Porteous expressed his unhappiness at David Cook's match reports, his point is that we are part of the club, Gordon Dickson says that David Cook puts in his reports his feelings and he is free to say that...the Trust is an independent body, has shares in the club and is a major shareholder. He felt that some of the negative ratings given to certain players could be detrimental to the players concerned.
- (d) Postponement of matches at Shielfield, Brian Porteous took the decision to call of the Reserves match the week before the Rangers game due to the condition of the pitch. This was raised as a concern as this was felt that this was not the real reason for the call off.
- (e) Presentation of cheque on March 10th 2013. This is to coincide with and to mark the tenth anniversary of the Trust. The Trust has been asked to publicise the new venture of Sunday lunches in the new Sponsors Lounge at Shielfield.
