## BRFC SUPPORTERS TRUST – TREASURERS REPORT YEAR ENDING 31st MAY 2022

Year on year subscriptions were down from the previous year at £5787 v £5392. This may be due to on-field attainment being lower than expectation. An improving trend of subscriptions expected as the club, management team, squad and performances appear to have stabilised.

Cost for the Newsletter was saw an increase from £520 to £973, due to increased postage costs for the larger (heavier) newsletter and general increase on postal charges. Costs for Website and Admin remained much the same year on year.

Donations to the football club this financial year totalled £978 along with football related donations within to community of £779, totalling £1756 in donation activity for this financial year; still less slightly less than trends from past years' due to slightly diminished subscriptions and curtailment of fund-raising events.

There were no Creditors at the end of the last financial term.

We are very grateful to Mark McLeman at J.H.Greenwood for completing our accounts this year free of charge. This will save us in the region of £300.

For information our bank balance as of today is £1,270 showing funds are at an acceptable level.

The accounts were prepared and signed-off by J.H Greenwood and we will be submit the Annual Return to the Financial Conduct Authority ahead of the required submission deadline of April 30th 2022. I can confirm all expenditure is approved by Committee members in advance, either at Trust meetings or by e-mail agreements. Financial updates have been presented by Andrew Allan at each committee meeting.
